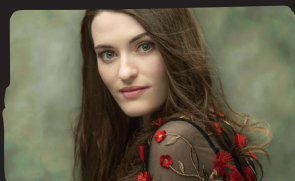

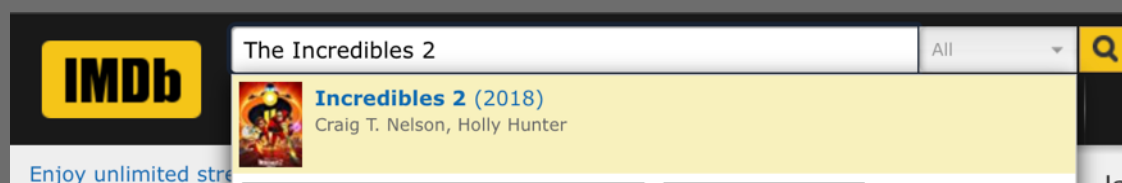


## IMDb Movie Website

IMDb is a database of movies and TV shows. The website has a fantastic section for parents.

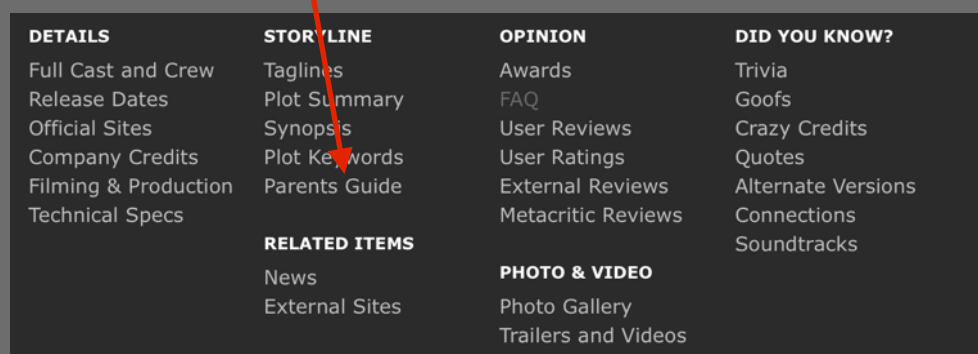
Simply search for any movie.

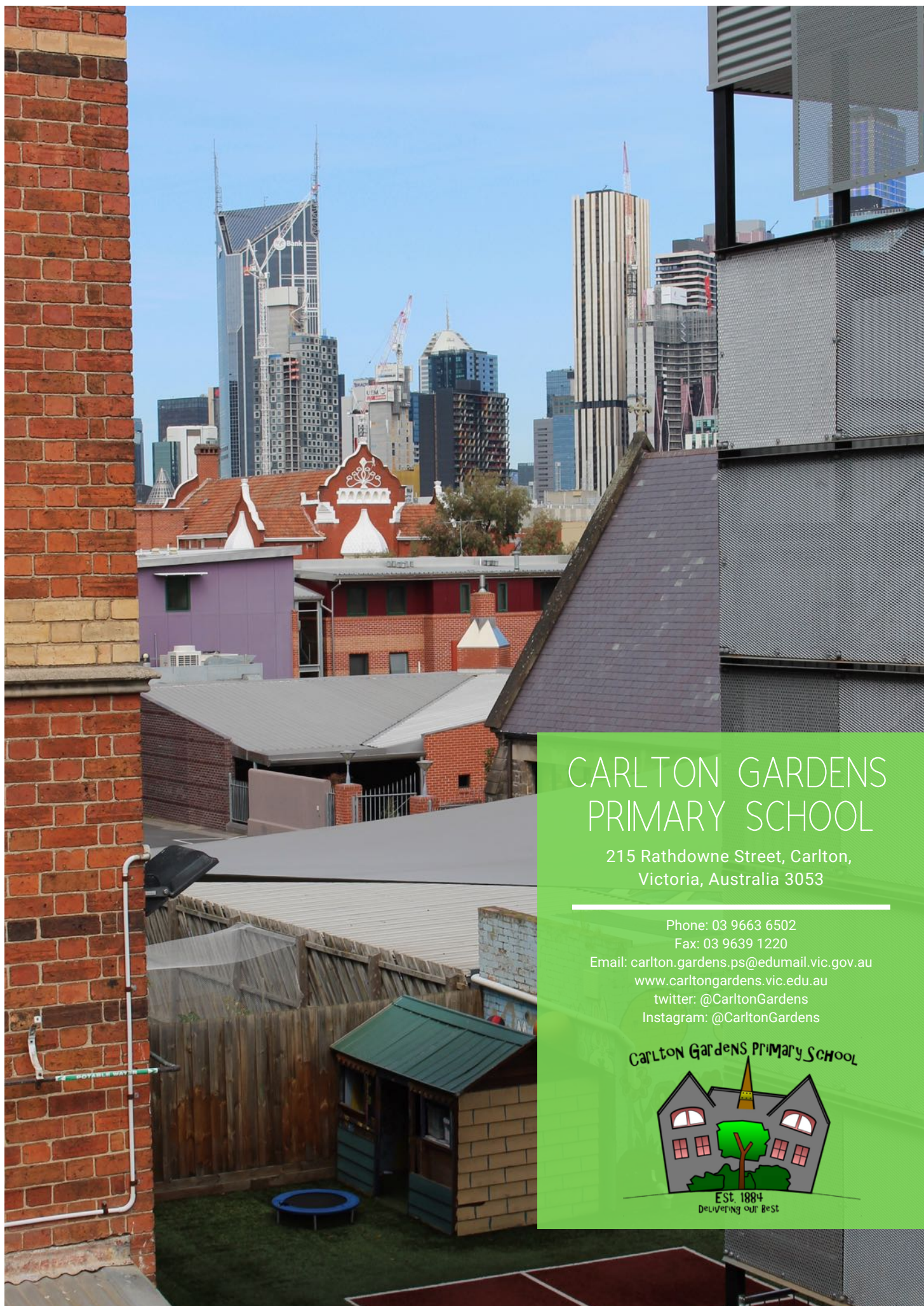
